Shetland Hamefarin Challenge – Quilts
Sponsored by Ann Hill, Quilter

1. The challenge is to produce an original quilt on the theme “Shetland Way of Life” – no bigger than 42” across in any direction.
2. The item should be made as a wallhanging or small quilt.
3. Quilts should be made from 100% cotton, wadded and backed.
4. A hanging sleeve should be attached on the back of the quilt.
5. It may be machine or hand pieced and/or quilted.
6. For the assistance of the judges, entries may be accompanied by a description of materials or special features used.
7. Your name should be on the label which should be attached to the back of your quilt.
8. Entries should be posted (or handed in to) Hamefarin Quilt Challenge, **SIC Economic Development Unit, 3 North Ness Business Park, Lerwick, Shetland ZE1 0LZ**, no later than 12pm on Monday 10 May 2010 accompanied by the completed entry form.
9. The work will be judged by an independent panel. The judges’ decision will be final. The winners will be announced at the ‘Quilting Show and Tell Evening” on Monday 21st June being held in Islesburgh Community Centre, Lerwick, during the Hamefarin festivities. A special prize will be awarded for the winner of the ‘Young Quilter’ category. (Young Quilter is defined as anyone up to and including the age of 15).
10. Entries will be returned at the end of the exhibition on 30 June, 2010.
11. Insurance of quilts will be covered while they are in the exhibition. Proof of postage should be available by both participants and the exhibition committee.
